

How to make an Open Class Entry (Still Exhibits):

*An Open Class Entry Form must be filled out for each individual entering. There must be a separate form for each department you plan to enter. Copies can be made at a cost set by the MCAS.

*If you are age 11 and under and plan to enter into still exhibits, you may go off your parent/grandparent/legal guardian's ticket when they enter. If a parent/grandparent/legal guardian is not entering then the child must purchase a ticket. This is for still exhibits **ONLY**.

Ticket choices to purchase:

***Season Ticket** (7 gate admissions) \$30

***Membership Ticket** (Must be at least 18 & Medina Co. Resident) (7 gate admissions) \$30

***Mini Exhibitor Ticket** (2 gate admissions) \$12

*Once you purchase one of the tickets, you can enter as much as you like in still exhibits, reminder each class only allows one entry each. We accept cash, check or credit card (Visa, MasterCard or Discover).

***Entry Deadline is July 20, 2019 at 4:00 p.m. This date is the same EVERY YEAR no matter what day it falls on. There are no exceptions to this rule.**

*Please make sure you check your entry form before you turn it in to make sure you have filled it out correctly, if you have made a mistake, you must contact us and correct it by the July 20th deadline. If it is not corrected by that date it will remain as it was turned in.

*Tags for the entered items will be ready by Thursday, July 25. You will pick those up at the Fair Office. PLEASE check to make sure you have tags for all the items you entered at the time you pick them up.

*Each department explains what to do with tags (whether to attach or leave unattached to your items), please read the rules. Also listed with the departments is when to bring in your items (date, time and where to go) as well as release times for the items at the end of fair.

*Premiums for your entries can be picked up at Building #14 (On Grounds Office in the middle of the midway at the South end of the Grandstands little red booth) on Sunday, August 4 from 8:00-9:30 p.m., please have an ID with you at the time of picking up your premiums.

*If you cannot pick up your entries and premiums the last day of fair, everything should be at the Fair Office starting Tuesday, August 6 (the Fair Office will be closed Monday, August 5). Premiums for open class is available for pick up until August 30, 2019. After this date, the premiums will revert back to the MCAS.

How to make an Open Class Entry (Animal):

*An Open Class Entry Form must be filled out for each individual entering. There must be a separate form for each department you plan to enter. Copies can be made at a cost set by the MCAS.

*Each person entering must purchase a ticket along with paying the proper premiums due for the animal(s) being entered.

*There are some departments that have exemptions for purchasing a ticket, please make sure you read through all the rules and classes before entering.

*Each department had their own set of rules for how many animals can be entered per class, please make sure you check before entering.

Ticket choices to purchase:

***Season Ticket** (7 gate admissions) \$30

***Membership Ticket** (Must be at least 18 & Medina Co. Resident) (7 gate admissions) \$30

***Mini Exhibitor Ticket** (2 gate admissions) \$12

We accept cash, check or credit card (Visa, MasterCard or Discover).

***Entry Deadline is July 20, 2019 at 4:00 p.m. This date is the same EVERY YEAR no matter what day it falls on. There are no exceptions to this rule.**

*Please make sure you check your entry form before you turn it in to make sure you have filled it out correctly, if you have made a mistake, you must contact us and correct it by the July 20th deadline. If it is not corrected by that date it will remain as it was turned in.

*Please read the rules/regulations that go with each department for the information of when to bring your animal(s) in, where to go and release.

*Premiums will be given to the department chairs, if you do not receive your premium check from them, it will be brought to the Fair Office and it can be picked up starting Tuesday, August 6 (the Fair Office will be closed Monday, August 5). Please have an ID with you at the time of picking up your premiums. These premiums are available for pick up until August 30, 2019. After this date, the premiums will revert back to the MCAS.
